St Mary's Merton Park

This year, it will cost about £204,779 or £3,938 per week, to run our Church and support all the activities described in the Annual Report. We rely on people supporting St Mary's by signing up to give money regularly through our **Planned Giving Scheme**. We encourage giving by standing order from your bank, or through envelopes that you place in the Church collection.

Income tax payers can help the Church even more through **Gift Aid** which allows the Church to reclaim the basic rate of income tax already paid by the donor. (If you are a higher rate tax payer you also keep the difference between the two tax rates).

Please help us to further the work of St Mary's Church described in this Annual Report.

How can I give under Gift Aid?

Gift Aid can be claimed by the Church on one-off donations, made payable please to 'St Mary's Merton PCC' and on regular planned giving. To support the work of St Mary's Merton regularly, please complete the following details:
